Cascade Clamp - Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing just 4 people. Overall sales for that initial year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. Through five years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is one of the leading worldwide producers within the material handling industry.

Production and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of new business possibilities. During the past 60 years, the material handling business has grown into a highly complex area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this improvement. Cascade presently continues to grow as the premier provider of lift truck accessories and various related products. The business feels certain in their potential to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the international market.

In the 1950's, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and advertising hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was completed in the year 1956 on a brand new office to be able to house all office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. After 15 years of business, total employees reached 180 employees and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Frisco a second manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the business recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production facilities throughout the U.S. with places in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Frisco. Cascade products are manufactured worldwide because of numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is made to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after buying 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
